PREPARATION OF THE APPLICATION

The documentation for each generation of the lineage must identify the individuals named and the relationship between generations. All proof and proof of service submitted shall conform to the present day standards of evidence even though an application may have been submitted and accepted at an earlier date with less documentation. All references cited to support lineage and service must be accompanied by a copy of the record. The title, author and date of publication should be stated on the document or a copy of the title page enclosed. All proof submitted must be legible. Please underline in red pen or pencil. DO NOT SEND ORIGINALS OR USE HIGHLIGHTERS ON SUBMITTED COPIES!

Birth Certificates, marriage licenses and certificates, death certificates, wills, deeds, probate records, family bibles, census records naming the individual and documents executed at the time of the event are considered legal records of evidence. Dates should be given by day, month and year – ex. 9 Dec. 1995. Generational proof must contain dates and places or other supporting information. Lineages accepted by another Society or unsupported statements in a county history, family genealogy or newsletter are NOT valid proof to establish a line of descent. Please mark each generation on the front at the top of the page. DO NOT WRITE ON BACK OF COPIES.

The basis of lineal descent makes it impossible for an application of adopted children to be accepted unless the biological, rather than the adoptive parents, are being recorded. If a surname has been changed, the change should be documented by a legal record or certified affidavit. Divorce data must be supplied when applicable.

When properly filled out and endorsed, the original application shall be sent to the State Registrar, accompanied by a check payable to the State Treasurer for all applicable fees and dues. DO NOT USE STAPLES. The State Registrar will review application and forward to the National Registrar for approval.
