DO NOT SEND ORIGINALS OR USE HIGHLIGHTERS ON SUBMITTED COPIES!

Birth Certificates, marriage licenses and certificates, death certificates, wills, deeds, probate records, family bibles, census records naming the individual and documents executed at the time of the event are considered legal records of evidence. Dates should be given by day, month and year – ex. 9 Dec. 1995. Generational proof must contain dates and places or other supporting information. Lineages accepted by another Society or unsupported statements in a county history, family genealogy or newsletter are NOT valid proof to establish a line of descent. Please mark each generation on the front at the top of the page. DO NOT WRITE ON BACK OF COPIES.

The basis of lineal descent makes it impossible for an application of adopted children to be accepted unless the biological, rather than the adoptive parents, are being recorded. If a surname has been changed, the change should be documented by a legal record or certified affidavit. Divorce data must be supplied when applicable.

When properly filled out and endorsed, the original application shall be sent to the State Registrar, accompanied by a check payable to the State Treasurer for all applicable fees and dues.
